DNSSAB Approves 2022 BudgetCost of Services Drive 3.84% Increase

North Bay, ON – The District of Nipissing Social Services Administration Board (DNSSAB) has approved its 2022 Budget. With this approval, the move to direct delivery of Paramedic Services can proceed as will continued investment into transitional and affordable housing services.

Nipissing District has the largest paramedic service in the province that is not currently delivered directly. With the change to direct delivery, a more nimble service interconnected with other human service programs will be the focus. The overall system will be more able to adapt quickly to change and community priorities. The investment in Housing Programs will support shelter and programming for people experiencing homelessness.

"DNSSAB remains one of the leanest District Social Services Administration Boards in the province," says DNSSAB Board Chair, Mark King. "Increased costs in the budget are directly related to the services we provide and investments into services for those most in need," King adds.
