Subject: 2018 Cost Factor to be used in 2018 Fiscal Budgets for Municipal Non-Profits.

Social Housing Notification Release 17-06

Background:

The cost factor is a regional inflationary/deflationary factor which is used in the calculation of operating subsidy in the budgets of municipal Non-Profit housing corporations. The cost factor for each region is reviewed annually and adjusted in accordance with changes in the consumer price index for the costs of housing operations.

This notification applies to municipal Non-Profit housing corporations currently under administration by local service managers.

Non-Profit's Responsibility

All municipal Non-Profit housing corporations must use the cost factor specific to their region in the calculation of their operating subsidy for their fiscal year beginning 2018. The cost factor is used in line 432 of the municipal Non-Profit operating budget form 810 (01/95). When used in the budget form, the cost factor is expressed as 1 plus a decimal number (e.g. 2.41 would be expressed as 1.0241).

Action: Municipal Non-Profit Housing Corporations will use 2.41% as the Cost Factor for the 2018 Fiscal Year Budgets.

2018 Cost Factors	
North-Western	2.53%
Northern	2.41%
Eastern	2.97%
Central	2.48%
Metro	2.58%
Southern	2.72%
South-Western	2.62%
